Updated attendance policy: there is a change to the attendance policy regarding lateness. The policy will be available on the school website shortly, but states:

Registers are marked at 8.55am.

Lateness is classed as any child coming into school between 8.55 am and 9:10am.

The register will be closed 15 minutes after the school's start time (9.10am). In accordance with the Regulations, if your child arrives after that time they will receive a mark that shows them to be on site, but this will **not** count as a present mark and it will mean they have an unauthorised absence.

This will affect just a few people and obviously special circumstances will be taken into consideration.

School Uniform: as we have come to the end of the school year, can I please ask that any out-grown uniform is sent into school for our second hand uniform sale. Any Y6 uniforms would be particularly appreciated.

School Fund for 2018/2019 : will remain at 50p per week or £19.50 for the full year. This money is used to subsidize school visits, and all the "extras" that the school budget cannot provide. This payment will be allocated to your SchoolsBuddy account in September.
