We regularly conduct staff meetings and training when school has finished and there may be times when there is **NO** supervision for children that are waiting to be collected. This can also be distressing for the children when there is nobody in school to collect them.

Can we please remind all parents that children should be collected **<u>promptly</u>** at the following times:

- end of normal school day is 3.15pm
- end of after-school club is **4.30pm**
- end of swimming lesson is **4.45pm**

Whilst we appreciate you cannot control traffic or public transport, please ensure you allow yourself enough time to get to school on time. Children that are collected late on a regular basis will receive a late collection fee. Please be reminded that there is an after school facility available at Sedgley Kids Club.

**Staff car park:** The car park is for staff only. Parents are not allowed to use the car park to drop off children when they are late. Parents bringing children to school late have to walk through this car park and moving vehicles make this extremely dangerous. All staff cars are stationary by the time the bell rings.
