Golden ticket winners: Evey and Eddy (brother and sister, what a co-incidence!)

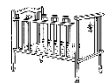


Welcome back to a new school year

Macmillan Coffee Morning: our first event of the year will be held this year on Friday 27th September starting at 9am in the DT room, with the sale in the computer bay. As the last few years have been such a huge success we will once again be holding a "Bring and Buy". A few reminders:

- **Belonging:** All your child's belongings - uniform, coats, shoes/pumps and lunchboxes - must be named.
- **Morning snacks:** the school operates a Healthy Schools Policy, so the only snacks brought into school must be fruit, vegetables, or a plain biscuit (Rich Tea).
- **Nut Allergy:** as we have children in school who are allergic to nuts, no nuts or nut product may be brought into school - this includes peanut butter.
- **Water:** all children may bring a bottle of water to drink from during the day. This must only be unflavoured water in a bottle with a sports cap.
- **PE kit:** all children need a PE kit in school; preferably in house colours.

Homework diaries: children from Y3 to Y6 have each been given a special homework diary. This is to record homework etc. Each class will develop the use of these diaries, but please encourage your child to make full use of this diary to aid their independence. Please take care of this diary as it has to last all year and a replacement will cost £2.50!



Swimming: starts for Y3 on Wednesday 11th September.

Parents must collect other children at 3.15pm, but may wait in school, usually in the DT bay.

School Nurse: Gina Appleby, the School Nurse will next be in School from 9.00am on Wednesday 18th September. She offers appointments on a first come, first served basis.

Dates for your diary: you will be receiving a separate list of all the dates which have been arranged for events in the autumn term. You will of course be sent reminders or further information nearer these dates. Please keep this safe, although it will also be available on the school's website.
