Parental Responsibility: we have had a few incidents over the past few weeks whereby children have been playing with footballs on the playground after school and parents have been hit by the balls. **Please be reminded that once the children have been dismissed from school at 3.15pm, they are your responsibility and must be supervised accordingly whilst on school premises.** Please ensure that your child does not bring their own ball into school as this is not allowed.



Absence: if your child is absent from school, please ring the school by 9.30am giving a reason for the absence. You can leave a message on the answer machine if necessary.

If you have **not** notified the school by this time, we will call the parent who is first on our contact list. **If we do not get a response, we will follow safeguarding procedure and call everyone on the child's contact list until we are confident that the child is safe.**

When your child is well enough to return to school, a letter must be sent explaining the reason for the absence. If we do not receive a letter of explanation, then it will be recorded as an unauthorised absence.
