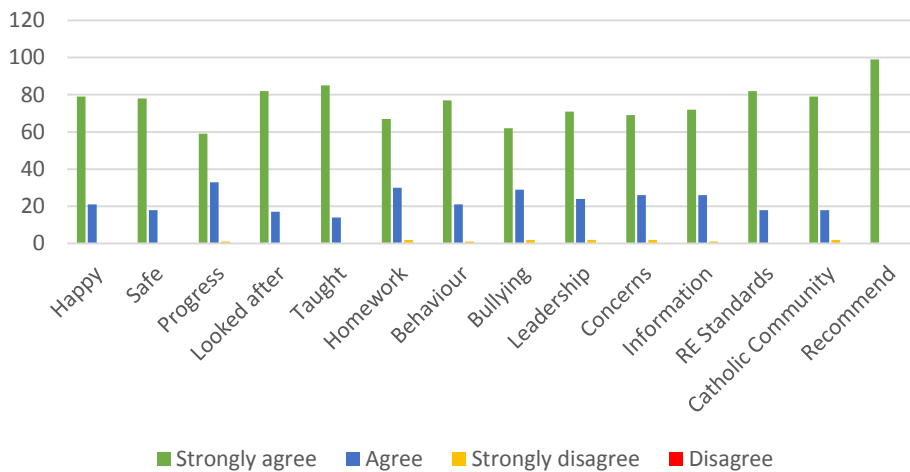
There are 160 families currently on roll. 89 completed questionnaires were received. This is 57% of families who replied. This is an increase on last year, so giving the questionnaires out at parents' evenings works well.

Areas for improvement:

Homework: is very much a "marmite" subject - parents either love it or hate it!

We received comments from parents who feel their child gets too much homework and an equal number from parents who don't feel their child gets enough homework. Some parents want more challenge, other feel the homework is not challenging enough.
